



















I am not one of the course's target audiences but willing to cover fees to take part in the course. Is that possible?

Based on the quality of applications, and the geographical location of the candidates, the ATP/IMC will select up to 12 trainees.


























Which are the most important criteria for selecting participants for the course?

The ATP/IMC seeks suitable candidates for the course.

Candidates should have the following attributes:

- Enthusiasm, passion for nature, interested in wildlife conservation in general, and turtle conservation in particular.
- Currently working and studying in the field related to wildlife conservation
- -The ability to learn and communicate well in English is an advantage.

























Is it compulsory to fill in and complete the application form in English?

The application form can be filled out in either English or Vietnamese. The language that a candidate chooses to use to complete the form does not affect the application's chance of success.




























They will learn skills to identify Vietnam's tortoise and freshwater turtle species; skills to conduct field surveys and interview surveys relating to turtle research and conservation in Vietnam, as well as skills related to teamwork and the presentation of scientific reports. Trainees have the opportunity to join a network of turtle conservationists in Vietnam.

























After the course, how will the ATP/IMC support students to apply the knowledge and skills they have learned?

The ATP/IMC has established a network connecting all the trainees who have attended the course so far. This network shares information about related courses, programs, or job opportunities so that new students can stay updated. In addition, the ATP/IMC will sponsor a number of small research projects for suitable candidates to conduct scientific research or complete a graduate thesis after the course.




















